

Final Examination—Contracts—Spring 2009—Professor Widen

Instructions:

1. This examination is closed book, closed notes, closed outline, etc. You must do your own work subject to the honor code.
2. You have 4 and 1/2 hours to complete the exam. However, the exam is designed to be completed in 4 hours. Thus, you have an extra 1/2 hour to allocate.
3. **Part 1** of the examination consists of three short answer questions with a recommended time of 45 minutes **to be answered in your bluebook or typed submission**. YOU MUST PICK **ONLY TWO** OF THESE THREE SHORT ANSWER QUESTIONS for a response.
4. **Part 2** of the examination consists of a single fact pattern that requires you to write a legal memorandum that explains some issues of contract formation and damages with a recommended time of 1 hour and 15 minutes **to be answered in your bluebook or typed submission**. Please allocate some time to think about your two short answers and your essay before putting pen to paper. Outline dumping and confusion will not be rewarded.
5. **Part 3** of the examination consists of 35 multiple choice questions and 45 true/false questions with a recommended time of 2 hours **to be answered on the scantron/bubble sheet**.
6. No deduction will be assessed for wrong answers on the multiple-choice and true/false portion of the exam.
7. If you think there is an error or ambiguity in any multiple-choice or true/false question or response, you may explain the problem or your assumption on the question very briefly for up to 3 additional questions (beyond the three questions that are subject to your two short answer responses) **in your bluebook or typed submission AFTER your essay responses**. Usually, your time is better spent on the essays than on wasting time for just a few points by explaining additional answers for the scantron/bubble sheet questions.
8. **Again with emphasis: Your multiple—choice and true/false answers should be filled in on the scantron/bubble sheet and not in your bluebook, typed submissions or on this copy of the exam.**
9. Assume that the UCC in your supplement is in effect (without proposed amendments) and that the Restatement (Second) Contracts is a correct statement of the common law in the applicable jurisdictions should there be a conflict with the case law that we studied in class. Don't forget that you also learned a few things about the CISG and assume it can apply in your jurisdiction. You will be told if you are to apply the law of a particular state (i.e. Florida) to answering a question.
10. Your baseline grade will be determined by your answers to the multiple choice and true/false questions. This baseline grade will be adjusted, as appropriate, up, down or no change, based on your essay answers.
